

JERSEY CARE & HANDLING POLICY

Team jerseys are one of the biggest single expenses that PCRA has to make from time to time. The longer we can keep our jerseys in good shape, the more money we have to invest in our athletes and other areas of our program.

Team managers will hand out one or two jerseys to each player at the beginning of the season and collect them when the season is over. Upon receipt of their jersey, each player must give their team manager a 100\$ deposit cheque (per jersey received) dated March 31 of the following year. This cheque is to cover the replacement cost of the jersey(s) in the event that it is not returned, lost, or suffers damage other than normal wear.

In order to increase the longevity of our jerseys, we need your help. We would ask that you strictly adhere to the following guidelines once you receive your jersey:

- Jerseys **MUST** be transported in the PCRA provided jersey bag. **Please do not use plastic bags to transport your jersey as it will create mold on the jersey.**
- **Jerseys are to be worn for games or official PCRA events only.** Each player must have her own practice jersey.
- Only names bars purchased at Stinger Sports since the **2015-16 season will be allowed.** Stinger Sports is the **exclusive** supplier, installer, and remover of name bars for PCRA. It is the team manager's responsibility to take in the jerseys to have the name bars installed and removed.
- For the letters C and A, they must be acquired from the equipment manager **ONLY**. They must be loosely stitched. **It is not permitted to iron them on.**
- Please air out your jersey after every game.

(Note: for bunnies, these guidelines also apply for practice jerseys, game and practice pants as they will also be supplied by the association.)
