Parents **SHOULD**:

- Insist that their child obey the rules.

- Promote the value of the effort.
- Applaud good plays for both teams.
- Set a good example at all times.
- Teach their child to be gracious in victory and defeat.
- Try to acquire a knowledge and understanding of the game's rules and regulations.

Parents **SHOULD NOT**:

- Reprimand their child or any other child when he/she makes a mistake.
- Criticize the referee.
- Criticize the coach's work.
- Criticize other parents and spectators.

Players **SHOULD**:

- Obey the rules.
- Show support and appreciation for coaches, referees and other volunteers.
- Promote the value of the effort.
- Set a good example at all times.
- Be gracious in victory and defeat.
- Acquire a knowledge and understanding of the game's rules and regulations.

Players **SHOULD NOT**:

- Reprimand their teammates when he/she makes a mistake.
- Criticize the referee.
- Criticize the coach's work.
